- _____ Class 500: Large Wallhanging—Pieced (any side greater than or equal to 40 inches)
- _____ Class 600: Large Wallhanging—Appliquéd or Mixed Techniques (any side greater than or equal to 40 inches)
- _____ Class 700: Small Wallhanging—Pieced (no side greater than 40 inches)
- _____ Class 800: Small Wallhanging—Appliquéd or Mixed Techniques (no side greater than 40 inches)
- _____ Class 900: Miniature Quilt—Pieced (no side greater than 24 inches and no block size larger than 3")
- _____ Class 1000: Miniature Quilt—Appliquéd or Mixed Techniques (no side greater than 24 inches and no block size larger than 3")
- _____ Class 1100: Art Quilts—All Techniques and Sizes—Must be your own original design to fit in this category.
- _____ Class 1200: Group Quilts (Quilts made by 3 or more people, i.e. Round Robins, Block Exchanges, etc.)
- _____ Class 1300: Clothing—All Techniques
- _____ Class 1400: Other Quilted Items—All Techniques (purses, table runners, mats, etc.)
- _____ Class 1500: First Quilt—All Techniques
- _____ Class 1600: Junior Quilters—All Techniques (quilted items made by person currently 15 and under)
- _____ Class 1700: FPQG Challenge Quilts—All Techniques (not eligible for prizes or ribbons)

1. Complete a registration form for each entry and return by March 15, 2010 to:

ALL REGISTRATIONS MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN MARCH 15, 2010.
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2. There is NO registration fee for Foothills Piecemakers Quilting Guild members or junior entries. All other entries must include a \$10 check per quilt entered and such an entry is not complete without the enclosed check. All shipping and insurance coverage are the sole responsibility of the entrant. Foothills Piecemakers Quilting Guild (FPQG) is not responsible for lost or undelivered entries.
3. Quilts entered may be pieced by one individual and quilted by another and still maintain individual status. Signage with the quilt will indicate this information.
4. No person may have more than one entry per class.
5. The Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to combine classes after registration forms are received. In the event classes are combined, a person may then have more than one entry in the newly combined class.
6. The Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to reassign a quilt into a different class based on size and technique.
7. All bed quilts and large wallhangings must be ready to hang with a 4" wide casing/sleeve sewn across the top on the back of the entry.
8. All quilts need to have a label securely attached to the back of the quilt or quilted project. This can be attached on the inside of clothing or purses.
9. While precautions will be taken to protect your entry, neither FPQG, the Quilt Show Committee, nor Morningside Baptist Church can be held liable for any loss or damage to your Quilt Show entry. FPQG will be purchasing basic liability insurance coverage through NQA on the entries. If you have concerns about the security and safety of your entry, please check with your homeowner's insurance agent to make sure your personal entries are adequately insured.
10. Delivery of Entries
All entries shall be delivered to the Registration Committee representatives at Morningside Baptist Church on April 15 between the hours of 9am and 12 noon. No entries will be accepted later than noon. If you need to deliver your quilt(s) prior to April 15, please contact Ruth Pollow at 864-244-0263 to schedule delivery.

Mailed entries must arrive by April 9. Ship entries directly to Ruth Pollow at the above address. Shipping and insurance charges are the responsibility of the entrant. Make sure the address for return shipping and a check to cover the cost of shipping/insurance made out to FPQG is included. FPQG and its representatives are not responsible for entries lost in shipment or delivered late.
11. Quilts will be available for pick-up approximately one hour after the close of the Quilt Show on April 17. Your receipt must be presented at this time in order for your quilt to be released. If you are having someone else pick up your quilts, please make sure they have the appropriate receipt(s) for us to release your quilts to that person.
12. Please sign your Registration Form and make a copy for your records. Only signed forms will be accepted.
